To: All Patrons, Staff, Students, and Parents

The Environmental Protection Agency's Asbestos Containing Building Materials in Schools, Final Rule and Notice, 40 CFR Part 763 requires that all and governmental school buildings be inspected and re-inspected for the presence of asbestos every three years after a management plan is in effect. This same statute also requires initial and annual notification of the availability of a management plan that outlines the steps to be taken to eliminate the hazard. We are very willing to comply with this statute because of our great concern for the well being of our students, staff and community members. Therefore, this Annual Notification is included with all registration packets for every student and is posted on the school website.

The 2015 3-year Inspection and Asbestos Management Plan for Pine Ridge Schools is available for public review in the Principals office anytime during normal business hours.

As a result of these inspections we must advise that some of the Pine Ridge School buildings contain trace amounts of ACBM's (Asbestos Containing Building Material) and are being closely monitored according to all applicable Federal Laws and Statutes. In addition to our 3-year inspection we conduct 6-month periodic surveillance inspections according to EPA 40 CFR 763.92 (b).
